

This is a very quick guide showing you the basics on how to flash the KK2 board with the LazyZero Flash Tool and assumed that you have the following, the latest version of JAVA installed on your computer and a USB programmer and cable


- Download the latest flashtool (V0.63) from http://lazyzero.de/en/modellbau/kkmulticopterflashtool
- 2. Download the new firmware from KK on the KK2 thread in POST 2076 http://www.rcgroups.com/forums/showthread.php?t=1675613&highlight=kk2&page=139
- 3. Connect the KK2 board to your PC using the USB programmer of your choice
- 4. Click twice on either the kkMulticopterFlashTool.jar or kkMulticopterFlashTool_SERIAL.cmd file located in the directory where you unzipped the flashtool
- 5. Choose your USB programmer from the list




6. Choose the Hobby King KK2 board from the list of controllers




7. Click on the folder icon next to the file box



- 8. Navigate to where you saved the firmware (hex) file
- 9. Click on the file
- 10. Click on OPEN



11. Click on the flash icon



Status messages are displayed at the bottom. When completed and all is OK, close the application, power off the KK2 board and re-install back on to your multi-rotor.
