On recommendation of the Golden Gate Park Committee, and on motion of Commissioner Orr, seconded by Commissioner Ruiz, the following resolution was adopted on 9/20/90.

RES. NO 15818 (SF Recreation and Parks Commission)

RESOLVED. That this commission approves the following rules for governing the use of model boats on Spreckels Lake, Golden Gate Park:

RULES FOR OPERATING MODEL BOATS ON SPRECKELS LAKE

- 1. Internal combustion (I/C) powered model boats, including nitro-powered boats, may be operated on the lake from 10 AM to 1 PM three days a week, Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday only. Sail boats shall have full use of the lake at all other times. Electric and steam powered boats shall have use of the lake every day in the areas outlined on the attached map.
- 2. I/C powered model boats most not be operated at speed in excess of 15 MPH and must not exceed a decibel level of 60 at full throttle as measured from the north shore. All nitro-powered boats must have mufflers.
- 3. All local and state laws must be observed in the interest of safety. Reckless and uncontrolled operations create unsafe conditions. Powered boats are to steer clear of all wildlife on the lake.
- 4. No more than two Nitro powered model boats and/or two gasoline powered I/C boats may be operated on the lake at any one time.
- 5. I/C powered boats shall be run in a clockwise direction generally and remain outside all restricted areas, i.e. the far east end and far west sections of the lake as well as the electric and steamboat operating areas.
- Operators of radio controlled model boats shall check to see that their radio frequency channel is clear before turning on their transmitters. Required frequency flags must be properly displayed on their antennas whenever in use.
